

ISOFOTON HAS STARTED A 1 MW ROOF INSTALLATION IN SARDINIA

- **This project is the first of two that made the company in the Italian town of Ottana**
- **The total capacity will amount to 2 MW**

Isofoton, a European reference in the Photovoltaic sector, has started a 1 MW Photovoltaic roof installation in the region of Sardinia.

This facility has a capacity of 1.09 MW and is in Ottana (Sardinia). This is a project of integration into the parking deck, which will feature 4992 IS-220 photovoltaic modules, manufactured in the Research and Production Center Isofoton in Malaga.

This is one of the two works portfolio that the Italian company, Isofoton also plans to develop Ottana 1 MW plant in 2010.

Isofoton Italy, a subsidiary of the company in this country, has done the project, whose operation will prevent the emission of 1,000,000 kg / year of CO2 around.
